We recently received the following information about Alan during our recent membership information check.

"I would like to add the years of service Alan spent with the bank.

Alan was demobbed from the British Army in 1948 and returned to his old job at the Midland Bank in Brighton at the same meagre salary he was on before volunteering for war service at the age of 17. In the meantime, he found his colleagues unfit for service had received promotions and better pay. As he felt dissatisfied he looked for opportunities abroad and joined the National Australia Bank Strand branch and shortly afterwards accepted a transfer to Australia travelling 1st class to Melbourne at the Bank's expense. Alan enjoyed his years in the bank and felt that he was mainly treated very fairly during his long employment - about 36 years.

Alan will be 93 next month but sadly Alzheimer's disease has him in care but in his retirement, he maintained a strong interest in the bank and particularly enjoyed his years in branches at Doncaster Shoppingtown (he was the opening Manager), South Yarra branch and Lansdowne Street East Melbourne."
